TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

I, Roumelle Bowen, Secretary State Board of Pensions, hereby certify that the records in the Comptroller's Office show that Mrs. Mary L. Leonardy, widow of Philip Leonardy received a Confederate Pension under Certificate No. 1032, based on service rendered by him in Company B, Third Florida Infantry, Confederate States Army.

Official Transcript from the War Department, The Adjutant General's Office, Washington, December 27, 1909, is on file as follows:

Comptroller, State of Florida, Tallahassee.

"The records show that Philip Leonardy, corporal, sergeant and second lieutenant, Company B, 3rd Florida Infantry, Confederate States Army, was enrolled May 24, --- and mustered in August 5, 1861. He was captured December 16, 1864, at Nashville, Tennessee, and forwarded to Johnson's Island, where he was released June 16, 1865, on taking the oath of allegiance.

Mrs. Leonardy also stated in her application for pension that she was married to Philip Leonardy in the County of St. John, State of Florida, on the First day of November, 1879 and that he died on the 19th day of June, 1905. That she has been a resident of the State of Florida since June 19th, 1856.
