On this day personally appeared before me, W. A. MacWilliams, a Notary Public in and for the said State of Florida at large, Louis W. Leonardy, Who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says; that he is 58 years old, that he is a native of the City of St. Augustine, St. Johns County, State of Florida; That he is the youngest brother of C.J. Leonardyn that said C.J. Leonardy enlisted in Company B 3rd Florida Infantry and served during the War between the States, that he returned from the War in May 1862 wounded, he was wounded in the left arm and left side of his body, he enlisted at the beginning of said war and served until he was wounded; he returned home wounded and did not re-enlist for the reason he was unfit for further military service, in fact his physical condition was such that he suffered from said wounds up to and until the time of his death, that deponent was about ten years old when his brother said C.J. Leonardy returned wounded from the War, and that he remembers well his brothers condition, that his brother wanted to re-enlist but was physical unable to do so; that he is well acquainted with Flora Leonardy, who is the widow of the said C.J. Leonardy, and she worthy and is dependent on a pension for her maintenance.
