On this day personally appeared before me W. A. Mac Williams, a Notary Public in and for the said State of Florida at Large, Kate Desselberger, who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says; that she is a resident of said County and State; that she is over the age of 53 years; that she is a native of said State; that she knew C.J. Leonardy in his life time and am well acquainted with his widow Flora Leonardy; I remember very well the time the said C.J. Leonardy returned from the War between the States, this was in May 1862, he came back wounded, he was wounded in the arm and in left side of his body; he suffered from these wounds until the close of the War in 1865, and these wounds rendered him unfit for further military service, in fact he suffered from those wounds up to the time of his death, he wanted to re-enlist for further military service, but his condition was such that he could not do so, he being totally unfit by reason of the wounds he had received from re-enlisting.
