Good Morning Doug,

Enclosed are some documents I thought you might be interested in having. The picture of the tombstone shows Ann Green 1805 to 1863. Yet she is not one of the names given to me for being busied in that Section and Lot Number. I believe that she is probably buried in one of the grave sites adjacent to Section D, Lot 162. I believe that Dennis and some of his family is buried in one of the adjacent lots. I called Catholic Cemeteries and asked if they could look the adjacent lot(s) to see if Aim is buried there. They stated that they do not have a map of the grave sites and they would not know, without a map, what the section and lot numbers would be. Therefore, they could not look up the information. I find this hard to believe as I did not have Section and Lot numbers when I called them about the headstone and who might be buried in that area. I have found that obtaining information from Catholic Cemeteries is not easy. So the hunt continues.

Hope all is well with you. I will keep you posted on any future discoveries I make. Have a great day.
